The primary objective of our July trip was to receive updates on the preparation and implementation of our 7 Synergies projects which were funded earlier this Spring.

To stimulate synergies between our grantee organizations and scale up their impact through collaborations, B8 of Hope called for applications that target collaborative projects last winter. We selected 7 projects which connected a total of 15 organizations. These projects involve partnerships that run programs, share data and resources, or develop mutual capabilities. A total amount of \$155,000 was distributed.

During the 3 week stay on the ground, the B8 of Hope team met with all grantees as well as other organizations (who are currently unfunded by B8 of Hope, but on our closest radar). This trip allowed us to evaluate and monitor funded projects through in-depth discussions and/or participation in several activities. We are looking forward to sharing information about them in our forthcoming 2022 annual report.

# > September: Partners in PEACE

September opened with a partnership between B8 of Hope and <u>Coexistences</u>, a wonderful Swiss-registered association that is based in Lausanne. We have interacted and worked with them for several years. This time, our collaboration focused on sponsoring part of the costs involved in the "Strengthening the Dynamics between Facilitators of the Israeli-Palestinian Dialogue" seminar which took place from September 4<sup>th</sup> to 13th.

Since its creation in early 2007, Coexistences has hosted 33 dialogue groups of 15-20 facilitators on the ground. This represents 100 years of facilitation experience when added up!.

These Israeli and Palestinian facilitators do not necessarily know each other, and their approaches are different. Through Coexistence's seminar for facilitators, all received a unique opportunity to share their field experience and toolbox while tackling their soft spots or areas in which they lack training. Throughout the 9 day event, a cross-fertilization of diverse, rich and effective practices emerged; contributing to this enriching experience was very rewarding. Several seminar facilitators lead some of our grantee organizations in their dialogue sessions. We are thrilled to have helped our grantees profit from Coexistences' capacity-building opportunity by co-funding the seminar.

On the last evening of the seminar, B8 of Hope joined the participants' farewell party. It was lovely to see our Israeli and Palestinian friends in Switzerland! Spending time with members of Coexistence and the Swiss families who hosted the Israeli and Palestinian participants was wonderful. This occasion also enabled us to compare notes with our contacts and co-funders from the Swiss Department of Foreign Affairs who were also present.

For the International Day of Peace, B8 of Hope partnered with <u>Interpeace</u> in support of their <u>Geneva PeaceTalks 2022</u> event on Wednesday, September 21. The event took place both in person at the Palais des Nations in Geneva, and on livestream in English and French.



The Peace Talks showcases the inspirational stories of people who make a positive contribution to Peace. The event was cofounded by the United Nations Office in Geneva, UN Geneva, Interpeace, and the Geneva Peacebuilding Platform with the support of the Swiss Government. This year marked the 10th anniversary of this wonderful initiative, and B8 of Hope is very proud of its contribution to this important milestone edition!



To explain the background, earlier this year, Interpeace spotted two of our "Mid East Storytellers" whose portraits and stories were showcased in our travelling B8 of Hope and Alliance for Middle East Peace Mid East Storytellers exhibit. Both Eran Nissan from New Story Leadership and Wassim Almasri from Alliance for the Middle East Peace (whose work we support) were chosen as keynote speakers for Interpeace's Peace Talks, alongside seven speakers from other countries.
